NEGATIVES, c1930 – c1950**

The negatives were originally stored in 34 separate boxes, and have been listed as found. (They have now been repackaged in into silver safe sleeves and acid free boxes.) Contents lists from the boxes (many of which had been re-used) have been retained (1140/36/3/402)

Plate sizes are given in centimetres. In a number of cases, noted in the list below, condition of the plate is poor (emulsion peeling from the plate).

The negatives were listed in detail by Francesca Ashburner (volunteer) during November 2004-January 2005.
