Evacuees	1975	75	Jack Rosenthal's classic WWII drama about Jewish brothers evacuated from Manchester to Blackpool.
Geh Kinde Geh	1991	15	Maria Charles and Bernard Spear star as a mother and father hosting a Jewish funeral.
Jew Süß	1934	104	British film adaptation of Lion Feuchtwanger's historical novel.
