

CAMBRIDGESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL  
(50MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER

IMPOSITION OF 50MPH SPEED LIMIT ON THE B1049 BETWEEN HISTON  
AND COTTENHAM

The Cambridgeshire County Council proposes to make an Order under Sections 84(1) and 84(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act the effect of which will be to impose a 50mph speed limit on Histon Road, Cottenham (B1049) and Cottenham Road, Histon (B1049) - a length of road that is currently subject to the national speed limit.

The draft Order, together with a map showing the road and length of road concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the office of the undersigned and at the office of The Chief Executive, South Cambridgeshire District Council, South Cambridgeshire Hall, Cambourne Business Park, Cambourne, Cambridge CB23 6EA during normal office hours.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order, you should send the grounds for objection in writing to the undersigned by 22<sup>nd</sup> June. If you require further information regarding this proposal please telephone Mike Davies in the Cycle Cambridge Team (01223 699913).
