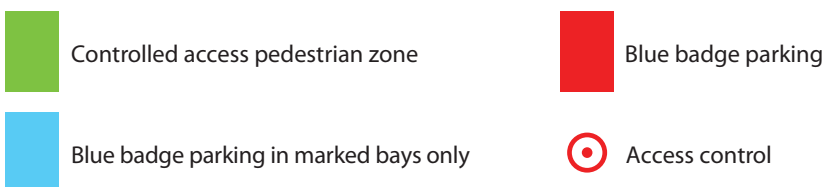


Access to Wisbech Market Place

Option 1

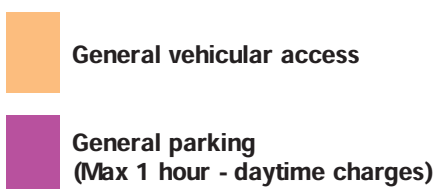


You will be able to access the market place by foot. Access for vehicles will be restricted to residents with off-street parking rights, delivery drivers and emergency vehicles by signs and physical barriers. The parking for blue badge holders at one end of the market place will be unchanged and additional parking will be provided in some nearby streets. There will be no parking on the market place.

Other features

- South side of market place closed to all traffic on market days, including deliveries. (Thursday and Saturday)
- Parking and unloading in marked bays only.
- Additional blue badge parking bays in Museum Square, Church Terrace, Market Street and Castle Square.

The Horsefair side of the market place will be closed to traffic. Traffic will be able to access the south side of the market place, Union Street, Market Street and High Street except on market days.

On non-market days, shoppers will be able to park on the south side of the market place (as shown in purple). There will be one hour parking bays on the south side of the market place, which you will have to pay for. There will be the same parking for blue badge holders as there is at the moment, but these spaces will also be restricted to one hour. Additional blue badge parking will be provided in some nearby streets. Delivery drivers will be able to park on the south side of the market place in unloading bays. Evening parking will be free.

During market and event days there will be no access for general vehicles, including delivery drivers. Both sides of the market place will stay closed to traffic, keeping this area reserved for pedestrians.
