

Cambridgeshire Retail Development Report 2005

This report, published in November 2005, gives details of shopping floorspace lost and gained between 1999 and 2005 for each district in Cambridgeshire. It also reports on proposed developments at 31st March 2005 (those under construction, with planning permission but not yet started, and sites allocated in Local Plans that do not yet have planning permission). Site by site information is given for each planning permission granted, and contains details of planning application number, applicant name, location, type of development, and floorspace.

The report updates and supersedes the 2002 retail report.

Analysis of data takes place at the County and district level and looks at yearly completion trends, whether development has taken place on previously developed land or not, and where development has taken place – for instance within town centres or on the edge of settlements. Analysis is also included on the Cambridge Sub-Region area.
