1. Always look behind, before moving out, when turning right.
2. Always give a 'lifesaver' look when turning right off a major road.
3. Always stop at the junction, when cycling from a side road to a main road.
4. Always look behind prior to stopping, when getting off bicycle.
5. Be aware of all other kinds of traffic (see notes below).

Safer Cycling Scheme Attendance Certificate

Following instruction in Cambridgeshire County Council's Safer Cycling Scheme, your child has successfully completed the course and will receive a badge and certificate.

This is only the beginning. The course has taught your child basic cycling skills and has aimed to develop positive attitudes towards road use, and to increase awareness of the road traffic environment.

In order to continue developing these skills, we ask that you encourage your child to cycle regularly, remembering that, in most places, the training took place at a quiet location.

The course has not taught your child to cope in heavy traffic conditions, only experience will teach these skills. We therefore recommend that your child is supervised in busier areas until you feel he/she is able to cope.
