- www.walkingworks.org.uk (developed by Living Streets) aims to encourage more people to walk to and from work, and to walk more during their working day.
- Cyclestreets (<http://cambridge.cyclestreets.net>) is a UK-wide cycle journey planner system, which lets you plan routes from A to B by bike. It is designed by cyclists, for cyclists, and caters for the needs of both confident and less confident cyclists.
