

SAWTRY SPEED REDUCTION SCHEME

Questionnaire

Speed limits help keep the roads safe for drivers and other road users and are more effective when drivers understand why they are there. The wrong speed limit will not only be ineffective but will undermine the value of other speed limits.

Government advice says new speed limits should be introduced only when the speeds of existing vehicles are within 20% or 7mph (whichever is greater) of the proposed limit.

The County Council will work towards the introduction of a 30mph speed limit in the developed parts of all villages. However speed limits alone do not automatically reduce vehicle speeds and speed reduction features may also be required to bring speeds down.
