

CAMBRIDGESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(BRIDGE ROAD, IMPINGTON)
(MANDATORY WITH-FLOW CYCLE LANE)
ORDER 20

The Cambridgeshire County Council proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police the effect of which will be to introduce a mandatory cycle lane on Bridge Road (B1049) on both sides from the entrance to the Holiday Inn Hotel to the junction of The Dole.

The proposed mandatory lanes are part of a cycleway scheme that includes improvements to existing lengths of off road shared use paths as well as new on road sections.

The draft Order, together with a map showing the road and length of road concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the office of the undersigned and at the office of The Chief Executive, South Cambridgeshire District Council, South Cambridgeshire Hall, Cambourne Business Park, Cambourne, Cambridge CB23 6EA during normal office hours.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order, you should send the grounds for objection in writing to the undersigned by 22nd June. If you require further information regarding this proposal please telephone Mike Davies in the Cycle Cambridge Team (01223 699913).
