1140/25/1/1 MEDICAL DEPARTMENT – GLASS LANTERN SLIDES 1918-1956, USED FOR LECTURES

Glass lantern slides, and a small number of coloured projector slides, formerly contained in one of a series of wooden boxes said to have been found in the basement of the Bernard Baron wing of the hospital and given to Frank Jordan.

The slides bear original labels, transcribed in the list below, together in some instance with numbers, probably relating to a variety of lecture series. The subject-based arrangement by which they were stored, and which inevitably fragments lecture series, has been retained.
