Proposed subject matter and area: The document provides guidance in relation to the design of waste storage, collection and recycling facilities required as part of residential and commercial developments and the requirements for expanded and/or additional household waste management infrastructure. The document applies to the whole of the administrative areas of Cambridgeshire County Council and Peterborough City Council.
