Cambridgeshire County Council (Various Roads, Carlton) (30mph and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 2024

Notice is hereby given that on the 15th May 2024 Cambridgeshire County Council made the above named Order under the powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (as amended). The effect of the Order is to;

Introduce a 30mph Speed Limit on Acre Road from its junction with Brinkley Road in an easterly direction for 595 metres, on Brinkley Road from its junction with Church Road in a westerly direction for 317m, Church Road the whole length and on Carlton Green Road from its junction with Church Road in a south easterly direction for 215m.

Introduce a 40mph speed limit on Acre Road from a point 595m east of its junction with Brinkley Road in a north easterly direction for a distance of 694m. On Brinkley Road from a point 317m west of its junction with Church Road in a north westerly direction for a distance of 400m.

The County of Cambridgeshire (40mph Speed Limit Order) (No.6) Order 1989 is hereby revoked.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks from the 15th May 2024 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
