

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER  
TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 SECTION 257 AND PARAGRAPH 7 OF SCHEDULE 14**

**The South Cambridgeshire District Council (Public Footpath No.7, Cambourne) Public Path Diversion  
Order 2021**

On 29 September 2021 the South Cambridgeshire District Council confirmed the above Order.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert Public Footpath No. 7, Cambourne from its junction with the A1198 (public road) at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 2999 5964 (Point A) and proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 729 metres to a point on the south-western corner of Swansley Wood Farm at OSGR TL 3047 6018 (Point B) **to a new line** commencing from a junction with the footway of the Cambourne West link road at a point at OSGR TL 3010 5959 (Point C) and proceeds in a generally but varying north westerly direction for 293 metres to a point at OSGR TL 2996 5982 (Point D), then in a generally but varying east-north-easterly direction for 245 metres to a point at OSGR TL 3019 5987 (Point E). The path continues in a generally but varying northerly then north-easterly direction for 286 metres to a point at OSGR TL 3035 6006 (Point F). The path continues in a generally south-easterly direction for 25 metres to an adoptable cycleway at point at OSGR TL 3038 6005 (Point G), as shown on the Order Map.

This Order came into force on 18 January 2024 but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
