The Children and Social Work Act 2017 introduced the requirement for local authorities to publish a Care Leaver Offer and extended corporate parenting responsibilities up to age 25.

If you are aged 16 to 25 and were 'Looked After' by Cambridgeshire County Council (in care) for 13 weeks or more following your 16th birthday, you are entitled to the care leavers support as set out here.
