Free WiFi

Free unlimited WiFi is available in all libraries except mobile libraries. To use it, you need to:

1. enable WiFi and connect to the network called 'CambWifi'
2. enter your email address and click 'Get Online'

You will be logged in automatically whenever you are in a [CambWifi network location](http://www.connectingcambridgeshire.co.uk/wifi/) (<http://www.connectingcambridgeshire.co.uk/wifi/>).

Printing facilities are not available through the libraries WiFi network.

Watching TV in libraries

To comply with new TV Licencing regulations that came into effect from 1 September 2016, all libraries hold a TV Licence, allowing customers to watch live TV, on-demand or catch-up TV on devices supplied by the library or devices owned by customers.

Note: This does not apply to Library Access Points (LAPs). Customers will need to ask LAP staff if their premises comply with the new TV Licencing regulations.
