How to join

Your library card will be posted to you. Please allow 10 working days for delivery.

 - **Aged 16 and above:** need one document with proof of identity and address. Introductory membership can be given if no proof of ID is available.
 - **Aged 12-15:** need a guarantor proof of name and address, along with the completed joining form, signed by the guarantor. However, introductory membership can be given if you can show us proof such as a school homework book or bus pass.
 - **Under-12s:** need to be accompanied by a guarantor who must provide one proof of his/her name and address.
