The County Council is part of the Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Local Resilience Forum (CPLRF), which closely monitors local drought situations.

Rivers, groundwater levels and aquifers were at seriously low levels at the start of 2012. In response the CPLRF produced a drought plan in the event of an ongoing drought.
